7 Ways ...to charge biochar

Manure

1.) Add water to your biochar until it leaks out

2.) Mix biochar and manure in the ratio 1:1

3.) Let it sit for 14 days and keep it moist



Bedding

1.) Substitute your usual bedding with biochar

2.) The biochar charges with the animal droppings. Use it after changing the bedding.



Compost

1.) Add water to your biochar until it leaks out

2.) Mix biochar and compost in the ratio 1:1

3.) Let it sit for 14 days and keep it moist



Co-Compost

1.) Add biochar to your compost pile over time

2.) Biochar should be less than 50% of the pile

3.) It is charged when the compost is ready



Mulching

1.) Use biochar and e.g. grass cuttings in a ratio 1:10 by volume

2.) Use it as mulch and apply a thin layer around your plants



Fertilizer

1.) Use half the fertilizer normally used for the area

2.) Dissolve it in water

3.) Add your biochar and more water until it floats

4.) Let it sit for min. 3 days, keep it wet



Urine

1.) Put your biochar in a container

2.) Add urine until the biochar starts floating

3.) Let it sit for min. 3 days, keep it wet
